



Lawrence Spradley

Lawrence Spradley was born in Freeport, Texas in 1968. He graduated from Alvin High School, in Alvin, Texas in 1988 and married his high school sweetheart Kristy the very next day (June 1, 1988).

Spradley joined the United States Army and was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division. From 1988 to 1996, his service included assignments in North Carolina, West Point New York, Hawaii, Alaska, Wisconsin, and then he returned to Texas after serving 27 years and never giving up his Texas residency. Spradley retired from the U.S. Army as a Sergeant First Class E7 Army Engineer (disabled combat veteran) and moved to New Braunfels in July 2015.
