b. (7) Political. Temporary **signs** advertising **political** parties or candidates for election or **signs** that otherwise provide for freedom of expression unrelated to any commercial endeavor may be erected or displayed and maintained on private property provided that they conform to state law and:

- a. Are no larger than 36 square feet;
- b. Are no taller than eight feet;
- c. Are not illuminated;
- d. Have no moving elements;
- e. Are placed with the consent of the property owner;
- f. Are not placed on or within public rights-of-way, on public property or within visibility triangles; and
- g. Are displayed within 90 days prior and ten days following the election for which they are intended.
